


Volunteer Programme



WHY ARE WE LAUNCHING THE YOUNG LEADER INTERNSHIP?

The Young Leader Internship is a volunteer programme that we are running to help school leavers gain experience of being part of a team whilst also developing their leadership skills and learning more about the gifts that God has given them.

We want to prepare our young leaders as best we can for life after education. This internship will bridge the gap and give young leaders the chance to grow before they go on to full time work / further education.



KEY FEATURES OF THE INTERNSHIP

VOLUNTEER WORK EXPERIENCE

Experience a real workplace environment as part of the Kerith Office Team. With the supervision of a line manager you will contribute to the goals of a Kerith ministry or operations team.

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

Young Leader Interns will have fortnightly workshops delivered by members of Kerith's leadership team.

MENTORING

Each Young Leader Intern will be offered coaching and leadership advice from selected members of the wider Kerith community.

DISCIPLESHIP JOURNEY

Learning more about the core truths of following Jesus will be a vital part of your journey as an intern. Young Leader Interns will be able to join in with the wider Kerith community following the discovery steps from our Growth Track, and taking part in a small group of their choice.

WHERE COULD I SERVE?

Kerith has so many teams that you could get involved with during your internship year:

PRODUCTION

Join the production team and get involved in video, editing, colour grading, lighting, sound, and all the things that the team do to make Sundays seamless and help people connect with God.

WORSHIP

Become a worship intern and help to organise and prepare worship for Sundays and be a part of helping people connect with God through worship.

KIDS

Intern with the Kids team to be a part of preparing and creating our Sunday Kids session content, helping children as they explore and deepen their relationship with Jesus.

SOCIAL JUSTICE

Join the Social Justice team and be a part of all they do to help those in need. If you have a heart for helping others the Social Justice team is an excellent opportunity for you to meet people and make a difference.

WHERE COULD I SERVE?

SITES

Support our Site Pastors making ministry happen on the ground through in a variety of planning and hands-on roles for Sundays gatherings and mid-week events in a site location. We currently have sites in Bracknell, Farnborough, Windsor and Freshwater in the Isle of Wight

YOUTH

Intern with the Youth Team to help organise and lead Youth events and help young people develop their relationship with God.

ENGAGEMENT

Join the engagement team to learn more about digital marketing, creating website pages, looking after the host team and thinking of creative ways we can help people engage with church.


EXPERIENCE

WHAT IS THE TIME COMMITMENT?

Here is a breakdown of how your time will be spent during the internship:

2 days per week (9-5pm) volunteer work experience

- Tuesdays, includes Office Team Prayer Time and fortnightly Intern Workshops (2nd & 4th Tuesday afternoon of every month)
- 1 other day based on individual ministry need, probably the day that includes weekly briefings from the supervisor and ministry/ops team
 - 2 evenings per week (typically 7.30pm-9.30pm) for Discipleship Journey in community based small groups
 - 3 days per week free to pursue paid employment or formal studies (e.g. St Melitus or WTC theology) or other activities
 - Ad hoc monthly Mentoring sessions arranged as suits

Spring term 2022


Tuesday 4th January 2022 to Sunday 3rd April 2022 Spring break: Monday 4th April 2022 to Monday 18th April 2022

WHAT IS THE COST?

There are no fees for the Young Leaders Volunteer Internship, but it's worth thinking through these important requirements:

- You'll need to be able to travel for work to your Site and/or our Bracknell Offices venues
- You'll need somewhere to stay. Unfortunately we are not able to provide accommodation as part of the internship programme
- You'll need a WiFi-enabled laptop or tablet as many of our systems are now cloud based"
